St David was born in Caerfai south west Wales into an aristocratic family. He founded a Celtic monastic community on the western headland of Pembrokeshire. He is believed to have died on 1st March 589. His final words to his community of monks were: "Brothers be ye constant. The yoke which with single mind ye have taken, bear ye to the end; and whatsoever ye have seen with me and heard, keep and fulfil."
