With the year that we've all had, this is the perfect time to ask some of life's big questions, to join the discussion, and to find out more.

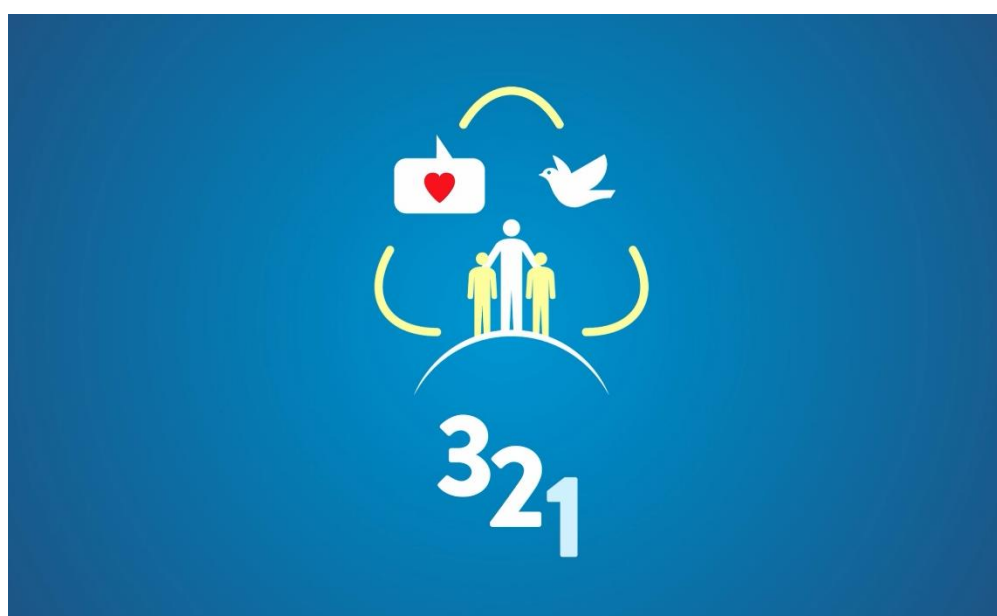
